Inquests

Nicholas has acted as sole counsel in a number of inquests, on behalf of both families and NHS Trusts.

He is currently acting pro bono for a family in an inquest into the death of a man following a 5-hour delay in the arrival of an ambulance.

Clinical Negligence

Nicholas gained extensive medical law experience throughout pupillage, and regularly appears in interlocutory hearings in the High Court and County Court, as well as advising parties on quantum and liability.

Public Law and Human Rights

Nicholas has a strong interest in public law and human rights, and worked on a range of high-profile matters during pupillage.

He is currently instructed by an NGO to draft submissions in proceedings before the Inter-American Court of Human Rights.

Environmental Law

Nicholas worked on a number of environmental cases during pupillage, and has a particular interest in cases involving nuisance.

Personal Injury

Nicholas has extensive experience representing both claimants and defendants in fast-track personal injury disputes, and regularly appears in a diverse range of trials in the County Court.
